This letter is to confirm that the Department of Family Services has accepted your recommendation stemming from your report dated October 28, 2015 and relating to file number 15-148-5 which stated that the ATIPP Coordinator and other senior staff within the Department of Family Services receive additional training with respect to their responsibilities under the ATIPP Act.

You will be please to know that the Department has already acted upon this recommendation and has provided further training to all of our ATIPP Coordinators including senior staff. The training was facilitated by the Government of Nunavut's ATIPP Manager and delivered in November 2015 by a lawyer from the Department of Justice specializing on the ATIPP Act. In addition, more training will be provided in January 2016.
